no longer has a function	produces digestive juice called bile	nutrients absorbed and move into blood, digestion completed here	stores food while enzymes break down food further	
APPENDIX	LIVER	SMALL INTESTINE	STOMACH	
secrete juices into mouth	produces pancreatic juice to further break down food	passageway for food from mouth to stomach	lowest part of large intestine, holds waste until it leaves body
