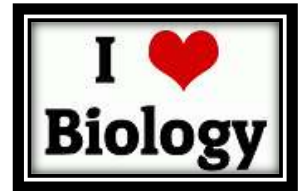


Blog / Science Around Me Posts:



For every **2 posts** you can earn a Science Around Me “Bonus” Mark.

- You may only post **ONCE** a week
- Find a unique example of the “topic of the week” in the world around you (ex. Comic, tv show, movie, book, magazine, newspaper article...) and write about it. Describe how the scientific topic was used, discussed, portrayed and/or what happened
- Must Include: Reference or a link required as part of the post



Academic Standards:

It is your responsibility to provide evidence of your learning within established timelines. Due dates for assignments and the scheduling of tests will be communicated well in advance to allow you to plan your time.

If you are unable to meet a timeline you must discuss with Ms. Loree the challenges you’re facing as far in advance as possible.

OVERDUE (LATE) EVALUATIONS:

- A **late penalty of 10% per day** will be applied to late assignments.
- Once the assignment has been **evaluated and returned** to the rest of the class, it will **no longer be accepted** for grading and a mark of “zero” will be assigned.
- A **missed test** will result in a mark of “**zero**” unless a note or phone call is received from a parent/guardian or prior approval has been granted. If approved, a missed test must be written in **the student’s own time** at a teacher appointed, predetermined time and date.
