- You may only post **ONCE** a week
- Find an example of the “topic of the week” in the world around you and post about it. (ex. Cartoon, tv show, movie, book, magazine, newspaper article...)

Include:

- Reference & a link if possible
  - Description of how the scientific topic was used, discussed, portrayed and/or what happened
  - Explain how it relates to the topic learned/discussed in class
- Posts must be **UNIQUE**, no duplicates



## **Academic Standards:**

### **OVERDUE (LATE) EVALUATIONS:**
