OVERDUE (LATE) EVALUATIONS:

- A **late penalty of 10% per day** will be applied to late assignments.
- Once the assignment has been **evaluated and returned** to the rest of the class, it will **no longer be accepted** for grading and a mark of “zero” will be assigned.
- A **messed test** will result in a mark of “**zero**” unless a note or phone call is received from a parent/guardian or prior approval has been granted. If approved, a missed test must be written on the “**Missed Test & Make Up Assignment**” day at the teacher appointed time and date.

CHEATING AND PLAGIARISM: Students must be made aware of and held accountable for academic honesty.
